## Spring Motorcycle Riding Prep

As the weather warms up, it's time to dust off your motorcycle and get ready for spring riding. Here are some essential steps to ensure a safe and enjoyable riding season:

### 1. T-CLOCS Inspection:

- **Tires:** Check the tread depth, look for wear bars, inspect for cracks, bulges, and dry rot. Also, examine the rims for proper tire fitment.
- **Controls:** Test the brakes, clutch, throttle, and handlebars. Ensure they operate smoothly.
- **Lights:** Verify that all lights (headlights, taillights, turn signals) are working correctly.
- **Oil:** Check the oil level and quality. Consider changing the oil and filter if needed.
- **Chassis:** Inspect the frame, suspension, and exhaust system for any damage or loose parts.
- **Stands:** Check the side stand and center stand for stability.

- If your bike was in storage, consider adding a fuel stabilizer to the tank. Start the engine and let it run to circulate fresh fuel.

### 8. Brakes:

- Test the brakes to ensure they engage smoothly. Check brake pads and fluid levels.

### SAFETY RECALL

#### 2020-2024 GL1800/B/BD/D/DA Fuel Pump Replacement

##### BACKGROUND

Honda is launching a **SAFETY RECALL** on **CERTAIN** 2020-2024 GL1800/B/BD/D/DA motorcycles to inspect and, if necessary, replace the fuel pump assembly. Due to a manufacturing defect, the impeller inside the fuel pump can warp or swell when exposed to fuel, causing the impeller to lock in place and prevent fuel flow to the engine. A locked impeller can cause the engine to stall without warning while riding.

##### AFFECTED UNITS

As of February 9, 2024, **YOU MUST NOT SELL CERTAIN NEW or USED** 2020-2024 GL1800/B/BD/D/DA motorcycles until they are repaired according to this Service Bulletin.

- To search for applicable recalls on a specific unit, you **MUST** use *Unit Information on iN*.
- To manage your affected new inventory, use your dealer *eResponsibility Report on iN*.

##### CUSTOMER NOTIFICATION

American Honda intends to mail customer letters to all owners of affected 2020-2024 GL1800/B/BD/D/DA motorcycles in April 2024. Customers will be informed that their motorcycle may be affected by a safety related defect and will be advised to make an appointment with an authorized Honda dealer for repair.

## ***You Can File Your 2023 990n Now... ... Or You Can Wait Until the 15th Day Of The 5th Month***

First off as I said last month, **“HE DISTRICT DOES NOT NEED A FINANCIAL REPORT FROM YOUR CHAPTER.** The same goes for Wing’d Rider.

The IRS website opened up on Thursday, January 18 to file your 990n. Remember once you submit your 990-N you have to wait a few minutes (a day is better) before you can check back with the IRS to ensure your submission was ACCEPTED. Print a copy of that accepted notice for your chapter’s records.

The actual link to the filing system is part way down the page you land on and is in this portion of the page from the above link...

Also very important... If the site you are on requests a payment to file, you are not on the IRS web site. Filing with the IRS is FREE.

**Now from what I learned when I filed for the District.** As I indicated last month, I put in a “Change of Address” form 8822-B in October. I DID NOT HEAR BACK FROM THE IRS IF MY ATTEMPTS HAVE BEEN SUCCESSFUL. I am assuming that it was. Silly me. The form can be found at <https://www.irs.gov/forms-pubs/about-form-8822-b>.

When I logged in to file the 990n, find this sign in block. You will need the email for your Chapters IRS account and the password.

### **Sign in with an existing account**

Sign in with  **LOGIN.GOV**

I used our new email address and old password. This was unrecognized. I then logged in with the former GWRRA email and password and that worked. I debated to delete the old profile or just file. I decided to file as a GWRRA entity to make sure the 990n was filed. There was a section that you could add a DBA (Doing Business As) name. I did list Virginia Wing’d Riders as our DBA name when I filed. I also found in that section, that if you want to officially change your name, you should send that name change request to the following address:

#1 You are riding your motorcycle on a four lane road. You are in the left lane and a vehicle is in the right lane. You could be in their blind spot. Then , the vehicle cuts into the left lane, cutting you off, and pushing you into on- coming traffic. What could have been your safest decision? Maybe you are in the passing lane. Do not slow down, speed up and pass the vehicle before they act or. Slow down and get to the rear of other vehicle. (SEE) see where other vehicle is, evaluate, execute.. Just get out of the way of other vehicle. If you are going to pass someone, just do it and move on out of the way.

#2 You are riding your motorcycle on a two lane road, doing the speed limit. You are keeping your eye on your rear by looking in your rear view mirrors. You notice a vehicle coming on you kind of fast. The vehicle rides your bumper as if in a hurry. What would be your safe decision? Slowing down would make the other driver up-set more. Would you speed up? Maybe there is a place for them to pass. If not, find a safe place to pull off the road, even into a drive way.

### ~~~False Sense of Security:

Automobiles have a lot of protection. A steel cage, seat belts, air bags, this can put car drivers into a sense of false security and lower their attention on the road. On a motorcycle, however, you know you have none of those things protecting you. In a battle of car vs. bike, the bike will lose every time. That's why the philosophy of "riding like everyone is trying to kill you" works so well to create a defensive mindset because when you get in the habit of anticipating the most dangerous situation that can possibly emerge while riding in traffic, you are better prepared to avoid them.

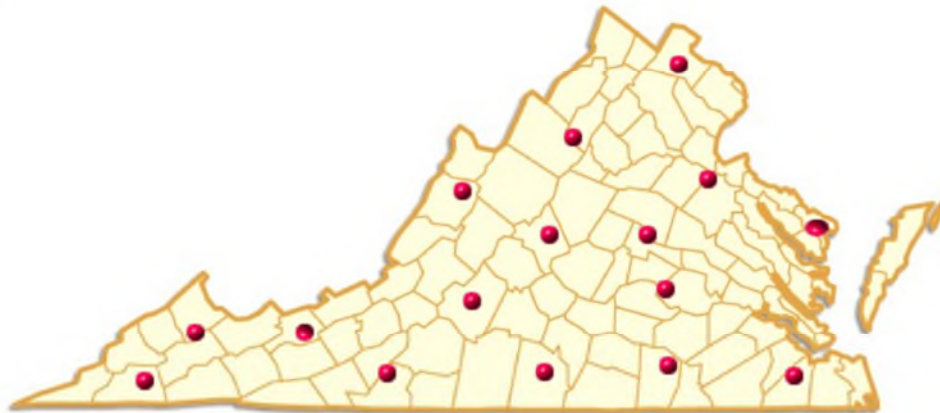

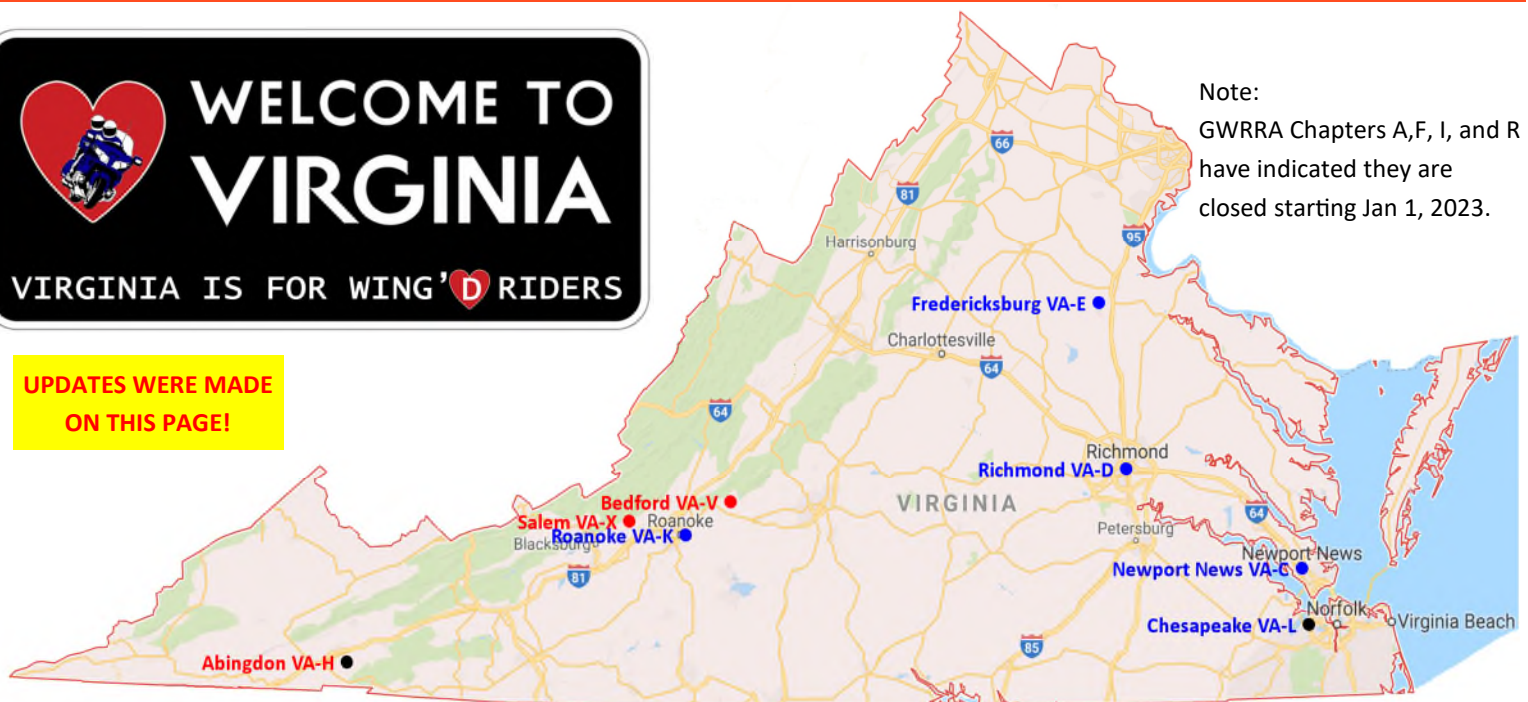
