## **You Can File Your 2023 990n Now... ... Or You Can Wait Until the 15th Day Of The 5th Month**

First off as I said last month, **“HE DISTRICT DOES NOT NEED A FINANCIAL REPORT FROM YOUR CHAPTER.** The same goes for Wing’d Rider.

The IRS website opened up on Thursday, January 18 to file your 990n. Remember once you submit your 990-N you have to wait a few minutes (a day is better) before you can check back with the IRS to ensure your submission was ACCEPTED. Print a copy of that accepted notice for your chapter’s records.

The actual link to the filing system is part way down the page you land on and is in this portion of the page from the above link...

Also very important... If the site you are on requests a payment to file, you are not on the IRS web site. Filing with the IRS is FREE.

**Now from what I learned when I filed for the District.** As I indicated last month, I put in a “Change of Address” form 8822-B in October. I DID NOT HEAR BACK FROM THE IRS IF MY ATTEMPTS HAVE BEEN SUCCESSFUL. I am assuming that it was. Silly me. The form can be found at <https://www.irs.gov/forms-pubs/about-form-8822-b>.

When I logged in to file the 990n, find this sign in block. You will need the email for your Chapters IRS account and the password.

### **Sign in with an existing account**

Sign in with  LOGIN.GOV

I used our new email address and old password. This was unrecognized. I then logged in with the former GWRRA email and password and that worked. I debated to delete the old profile or just file. I decided to file as a GWRRA entity to make sure the 990n was filed. There was a section that you could add a DBA (Doing Business As) name. I did list Virginia Wing’d Riders as our DBA name when I filed. I also found in that section, that if you want to officially change your name, you should send that name change request to the following address:

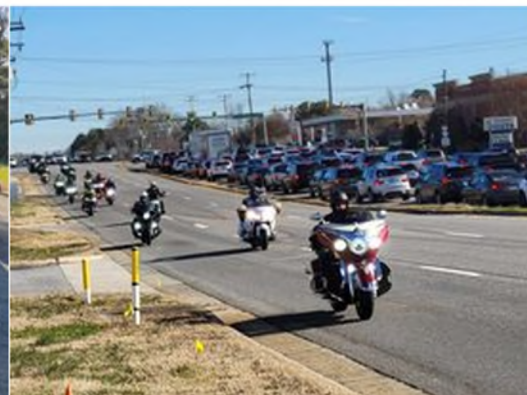

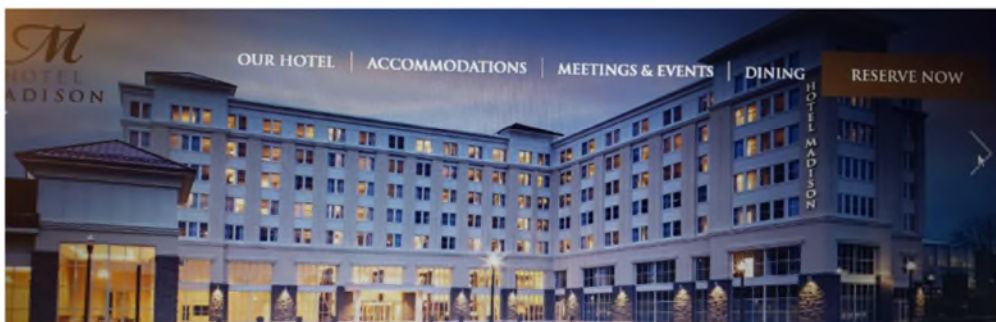

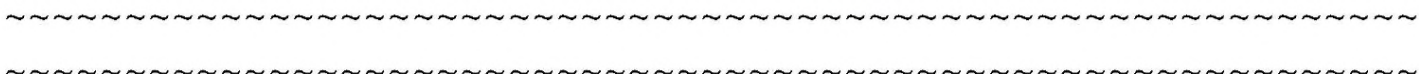

## Black History Month

### Origins of Black History Month

The story of Black History Month begins in 1915, half a century after the Thirteenth Amendment abolished slavery in the United States.

That September, the Harvard-trained historian Carter G. Woodson and the prominent minister Jesse E. Moorland founded the Association for the Study of Negro Life and History (ASNLH), an organization dedicated to researching and promoting achievements by Black Americans and other peoples of African descent. Known today as the Association for the Study of African American Life and History (ASALH), the group sponsored a national Negro History week in 1926, choosing the second week of February to coincide with the birthdays of Abraham Lincoln and Frederick Douglass. The event inspired schools and communities nationwide to organize local celebrations, establish history clubs and host performances and lectures. Did you know? The NAACP was founded on February 12, 1909, the centennial anniversary of the birth of Abraham Lincoln.

In the decades that followed, mayors of cities across the country began issuing yearly proclamations recognizing "Negro History Week." By the late 1960s, thanks in part to the civil rights movement and a growing awareness of Black identity, "Negro History Week" had evolved into Black History Month on many college campuses. President Gerald Ford officially recognized Black History Month in 1976, calling upon the public to "seize the opportunity to honor the too-often neglected accomplishments of Black Americans in every area of endeavor throughout our history."

Today, Black History Month is a time to honor the contributions and legacy of African Americans across U.S. history and society—from activists and civil rights pioneers such as Harriet Tubman, Sojourner Truth, Marcus Garvey, Martin Luther King Jr., Malcolm X and Rosa Parks to leaders in industry, politics, science, culture and more.



## Warmer temperatures = more motorcyclists, crashes in Virginia; How can you be prepared?

VIRGINIA BEACH, Va. — With unseasonably warm temperatures this February, drivers may notice more motorcyclists on the road.

Virginia DMV is spreading the word about a February Motorcycle Safety Campaign from February 19 to March 4. It states that the ongoing support of our traffic safety partners is needed as we continue to educate the motorcycle community on the importance of motorcycle training, slowing down, and alertness when riding on non-interstate roads.

When looking at fatal motorcycle crashes, there are three factors that stand out, according to the DMV: lack of training, speeding, and non-interstate roadways.

Sgt. Brian Ricardo with Virginia Beach Police Department agrees that one major factor they see with motorcycle accidents is motorcyclists riding out of their capabilities. For example, new riders taking country roads with sharp turns or driving during rush hour. He also says excessive speed is a common element. In fact, Sgt Ricardo told News 3 they just worked a fatal crash last week where speeding was involved.

“It’s unfortunate for everybody. It’s unfortunate for the motorcyclist who was killed. It’s unfortunate for the motorcyclist’s family that was involved, and it’s unfortunate for that driver that just happened to be turning in front of that motorcycle,” Sgt Ricardo stated.

He added another piece of advice for riders.

“Pay attention, look where you’re going, especially when you’re coming into intersections. And especially when people are turning left or turning right in front of you. That’s when we see a big percentage of our crashes.”
